


TOURISM INITIATIVES IN FACE OF COVID PANDEMIC



- As a result of Covid-19 pandemic, tourism levels in the city fell substantially.
- Currently the levels are almost back to pre-Covid levels (exp. 2022 will be -5% compared to 2019), implying similar demand for tourism services as before the pandemic
- However as a result of change in tourists'
 decision making process, as well as internal
 plans for efficiency, data-driven decision
 making and sustainability, the measures
 applied by the city tourism attraction
 agency changed accordingly.

DIGITALIZATION OF TOURISM CONTENT



- During 2020-2021, digital platform was created to store all necessary information for tourists, including personalization options, maps, routes, direct links to places of interest (i.e. hotels, restaurants, museums, etc.)
- Additionally, data gathered from users using the platform helps the decision making process in terms of route optimization, public infrastructure for tourists, languages

PURCHASE

- In cooperation with one Lithuanian discount aggregator company, we launched a city gift card, which allows a person to choose from over 100 service/product suppliers based in Kaunas.
- Not only it helps to attract recipients of the card to the city, it also helps to understand spending patterns, sequences, seasonality and interests

TALENT RETENTION

- City agency Kaunas IN runs 2-3 specialized campaigns per years together with stakeholders (universities, companies) ir order to achieve one of the goals: a) increase the number of new students applying to prioritized study programmes, b) retain the graduates once they graduate from Kaunas higher educational institutions and c) attract foreign and local talent to settle in Kaunas
- Career in Kaunas website serves as a database, filled out and updated by each respective stakeholder, in order to track the effectiveness of programmes and pivot them in a timely manner

Development Operations (DevOps) Engineer

The DevOps Engineer oversees all cross-departmental software communications engineering, quality assurance (QA), and cross-party smooth operation on IT projects. Their daily work consists of writing code in various programming languages, developing applications, scaling infrastructure, creating virtual environments, and automating systems and procedures.

KAUNAS DIGITAL TWIN

- In various industries, digital twins are used as real-time virtual representations of realworld physical systems or process technologies. A digital twin serves as a counterpart of a physical object for practical purposes, such as system simulation, integration, testing, monitoring, and maintenance.
- Kaunas Digital Twin was created using the OpenCities Planner platform from infrastructure engineering software company Bentleys, Inc.



UTILIZATION OF MUNICIPALITY'S INFRASTRUCTURE

- City is responsible for maintaing the school network, hence it has direct interest in utilising it as effectivelly as possible
- All sport halls and gyms owned by the schools are pooled into a single system, offering the user a possiblity to rent it out after regular working hours
- In 2022 alone, more than 1100 bookings were made and it generated more than 130k EUR for the city budget, allowing to cover the growing energy costs






